### WILL I NEED A SPECIAL LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION?

Every accountant filing a report with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) is required by law to be a Certified Public Accountant (CPA). Many others become a CPA to enhance their job prospects or to gain clients.
