Developmental Delays

- In the first few years of life, 700-1,000 new neural connections form every second.
- 1 in 6 children aged 3-17 years have developmental disabilities.
- Children with developmental problems are at increased risk for poor outcomes in many areas important to health, well-being, and success in life.
- Less than half of disabilities are identified before starting school.



Early Childhood in Texas

- Early Childhood Intervention (ECI) services are provided for children 0-3y IF they qualify.
 - Most children with developmental delays are not identified early enough for them to benefit from early intervention services.
- Even when families are referred, many children do not end up getting needed support. In Travis County FY17:
 - 2,686 children referred to ECI
 - 1,528 went through eligibility process
 - 936 qualified



The Learn the Signs, Act Early Program

- The Learn the Signs, Act Early (LTSAE) program provides education and resources to help childcare providers and parents to monitor development.
- LTSAE tools offer information on:
 - What developmental milestones are
 - What milestones to look for at different ages
 - Guidance on when and how to recommend to parents that their child get developmentally screened by a pediatrician or ECI provider

- Watch Me! Training video 1 hour (free) for early care providers on how to monitor child development






ConnectATX



- ConnectATX is a community tool that connects people with programs and services that are free or reduced cost.
- It is a comprehensive database with phone and chat lines with bilingual staff.
- It includes a **social determinants of health assessment** to go deeper with clients and ensure they get help they need.
