Interview Process

The STAR Technique

S

R

- Situation: Briefly explain the background, which company, job, and situation in which you found yourself
- Task: Specifically explain what you had to accomplish, overcome, or solve.
- Action: Specifically explain what you did and why you chose to take that action.
- Results: Quantify and/or qualify the results of your actions. Did you solve it? Did it save or make money? Did it improve a process, a relationship, etc.? How did you ADD VALUE?

What is STAR?

- A very popular technique designed to help recall and give the best response to behavioralbased questions.
- It helps capture the main areas that interviewers are looking for in a response.
- It provides letters to guide in presenting thoughts and experience in an orderly manner.
