





The program offers young adults, ages 16 to 24, the opportunity to complete their education by earning a high school diploma at our on-site charter school or in our instructor-led GED program. No experience is required and participants

receive paid career training and industry certifications in computer technology, healthcare, or green construction.

AmeriCorps Grad Crew and Career Pathways
