

Early Learning Program Updates

- <u>COVID Closures</u> If you have to close due to Covid, please be sure to let us know. Please send your license number, closure and anticipated reopening dates, and who is effected (whole school, certain classrooms, # of children).
- <u>Reporting Absences</u> All programs are asked to report each time that a child has 5 consecutive absences.
 Please connect with parents and encourage regular attendance.
- <u>Child Care Availability Portal Unavailable</u> Now through the end of May, the Child Care Availability Portal will rely on information gathered through the Child Care Relief Fund to remain updated. Programs can update the Portal again starting in June.

Child Care for Essential Workers (City of Austin)

- Workforce Solutions received funding from the City of Austin and CDBG to provide child care for children of Essential Workers in the following categories:
 - Child care Industry (teachers, caregivers, etc.)
 - Education (teachers, support staff, bus drivers, etc.)
 - Pharmacy and Healthcare Workers
 - First Responders
 - Critical Infrastructure (Grocery, Utilities, Trucking, etc.)
 - Other Infrastructure Workers (State and Local Government, Mail/Deliver Services, Banking, Gas Stations, Military, Restaurant and other Food Delivery, etc.)
- *NEW* Families must live in Travis County (includes residents living outside of the COA full purpose boundary), meet the income guidelines, and have at least one parent working in a category above.
- Families must select a TRS quality rated center with this program.
- Providers are asked to provide true attendance for any child enrolled in this program.

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Child Care Relief Fund 2022- Applications Sent!

The Texas Workforce Commission is **now accepting applications** for the 2022 <u>Child Care Relief Fund</u>! A total of \$3.45 billion is available for eligible child care providers across the state. **Applications will be accepted until** <u>May 31, 2022</u>.

Eligible providers received an email invitation directing them to the online application portal. Invitations were sent to the email address listed with Child Care Regulation. If you believe you are eligible but cannot find your invitation, check your spam or junk folder or reach out to the technical assistance team for help.

Agents are ready to answer questions and provide support free of charge in several languages between **7:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday** and **8:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. on Saturday**. Providers can contact the technical assistance team by:


T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® Texas is a comprehensive scholarship model designed to retain early childhood professionals through increasing their education and compensation.
