KinderSystem Tools

The new system allows parents and caregivers (referred to as "sponsors") to report child care attendance through the following KinderSystems tools:

KinderConnect:



A web-based portal for providers to track and share attendance data with state or local Workforce Solutions staff.

KinderSign



An app for iPads and Android tablets that helps sponsors log a child's attendance at the provider location.

KinderSmart



A mobile app for smartphones (iOS/Android) that allows sponsors to record attendance on their personal devices.

Absences

Absences for all children will be reset to zero on August 3rd. Beginning August 4th, we'll begin tracking absences again. If your child has more than 40 absences within a 12-month eligibility period, they may lose their child care scholarship. We'll notify you when your child reaches 15 and 30 absences to help you keep track. Caregivers can submit documentation for absences related to chronic illness or court-ordered custody/visitation to have them credited.

Note for Families:

If your child care provider uses their own Child Care Management (CCM) software (such as BrightWheel), you do not need to use KinderSign or KinderSmart. You will continue using the provider's system to record attendance, and the information will be automatically shared with the state system.
