Claims Adjusters, Examiners and Investigators

Accidents happen. That's why it's important to have insurance. But insurance claims can get confusing as when drivers disagree about who hit who. Someone needs to investigate the insurance claim to figure out who should pay the damages. The investigator looks for the truth when there's a disagreement about who is legally responsible or when criminal activity is suspected. In other situations, adjusters and examiners are the ones who deal with insurance claims.

If you are interested in doing detective work to reconstruct accidents, a career as a **claims adjuster, examiner or investigator** may be for you.

Claims adjusters, examiners and investigators work behind the scenes, usually for insurance companies or agencies, to make sure that insurance customers claiming payment get the money they're entitled to receive.
