Compliance officers combine the skills of scientists and law enforcement officers. In this field, you'll make sure organizations, such as factories, construction companies and electric companies, follow government rules designed to protect the environment and public health. You'll make routine inspections, investigate complaints and report those who break laws. You'll test air, water and soil samples and stud the results.

Do you have a passion for nature and an interest in the law? If so, a career as a **compliance officer** may be for you.

Compliance officers make sure that organizations follow environmental regulations.

Planning and performing government functions at the local, state and federal levels, including governance, national security, foreign service, planning, revenue and taxation and regulations.
