As a physical therapist assistant, you'll work under the supervision of a physical therapist to help patients whose ability to move is impaired, from injured athletes to disabled children.

If you are interested in a career where you can change lives by helping people become more mobile and gain independence, a career as a **physical therapist assistant** may be for you.

Physical therapist assistants work with physical therapists to help patients with exercises and other therapeutic treatments, such as bathing, applying hot and cold packs, and massaging.

It Helps To Be...

Strong, patient, and a clear communicator. Work can be physically and emotionally demanding, and you'll often be required to give instructions to the patient.

A Day In The Life...

- Instruct, motivate, safeguard, and assist patients as they practice exercises or functional activities.
- Observe patients during treatments to compile and evaluate data on their responses and progress and provide results to physical therapist in person or through progress notes.
- Secure patients into or onto therapy equipment.
