- Clean teeth and examine oral areas, head and neck for signs of oral disease
- Record and review patient medical histories
- Expose and develop x-ray film
- Chart conditions of decay and disease for diagnosis and treatment by dentist
- Administer local anesthetic agents
- Remove sutures and dressings
- Make impressions for study casts
