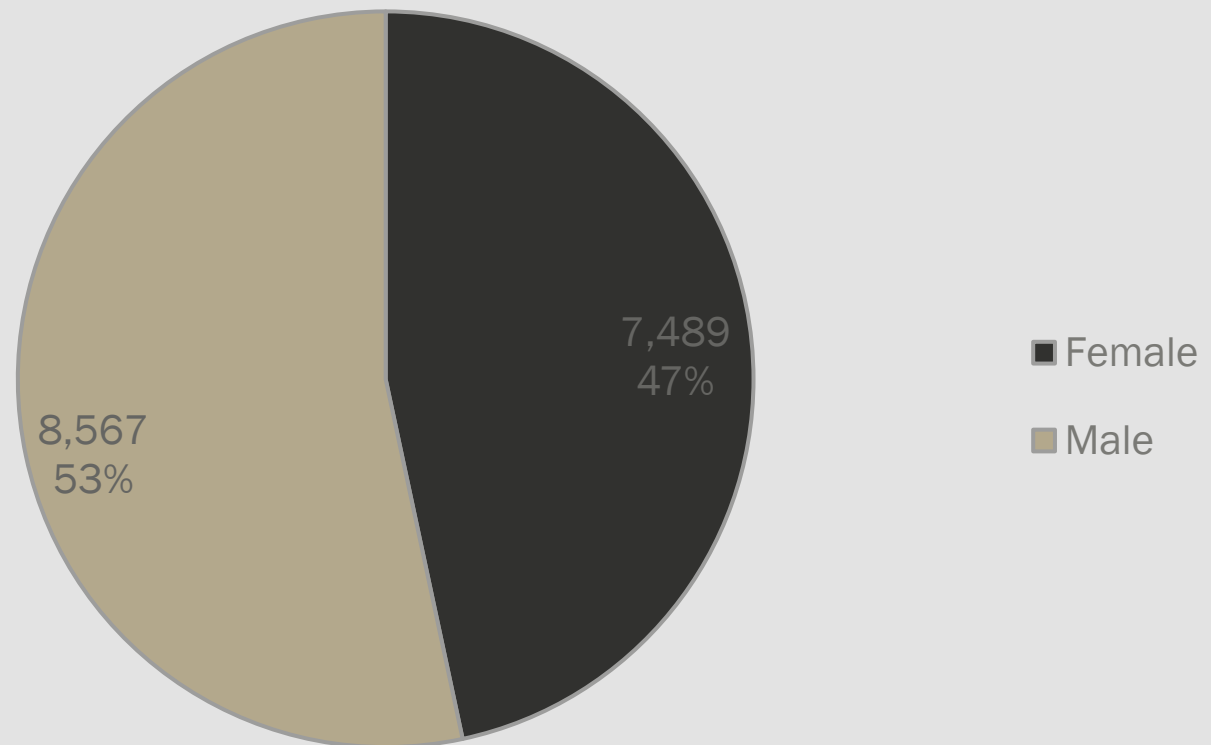
Unemployment Insurance Claimants in Travis County

- In Program Year 2019 (July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019), 16,056 Travis County, TX residents who were actively seeking employment received Unemployment Insurance (UI) from the Texas Workforce Commission.
- As the local workforce development board serving Travis County, Workforce Solutions Capital Area works with job seekers, including UI claimants, to
 - Find a Job
 - Build a Resume
 - Prepare for Interviews
 - Gain Occupational Skills
- The following slides represent demographic data on UI claimants who were:
 - *Within 10 weeks of filing an initial claim,*
 - *Determined monetarily eligible for UI, AND*
 - *Subject to work search.*

UI Claimants by Gender

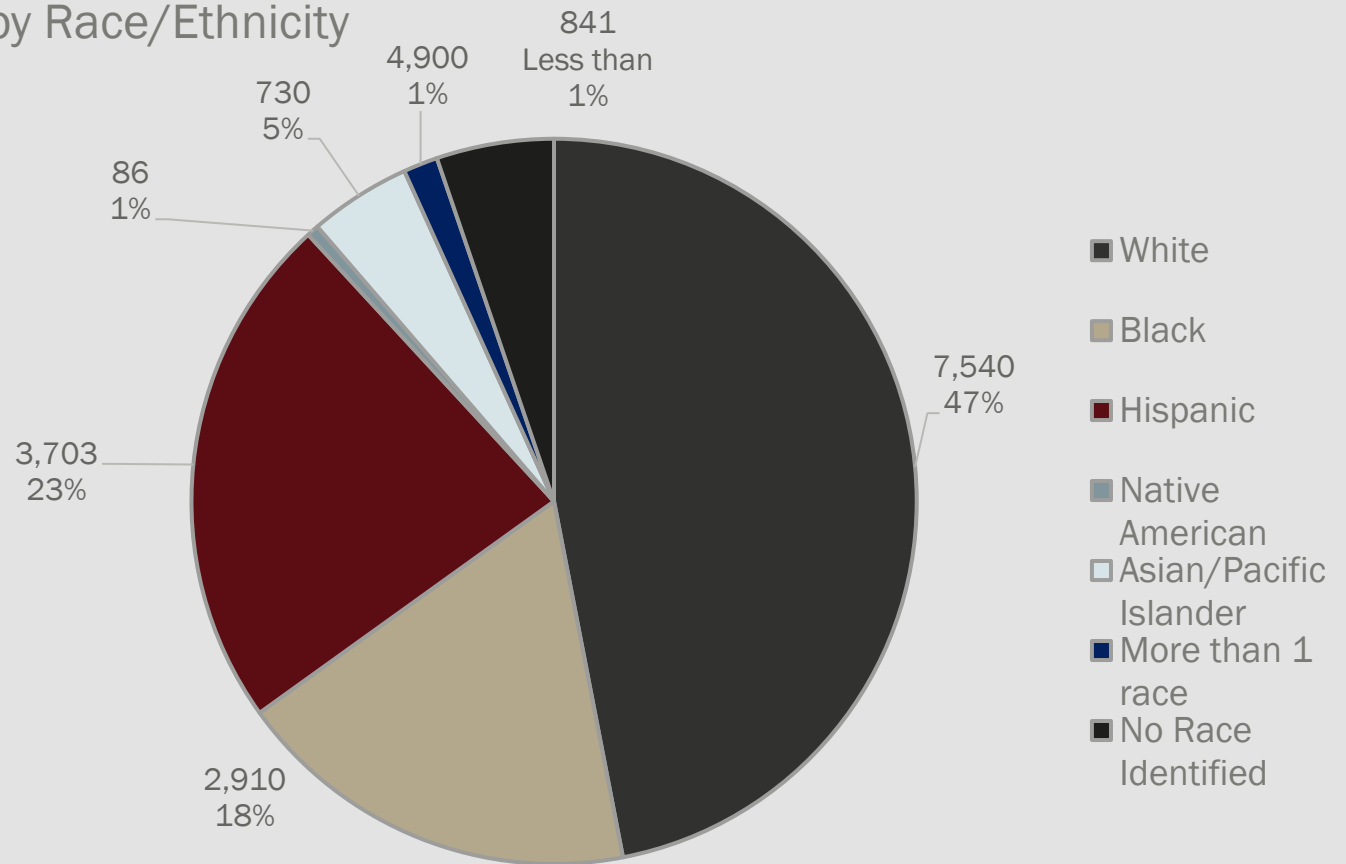

UI Claimants by Race/Ethnicity

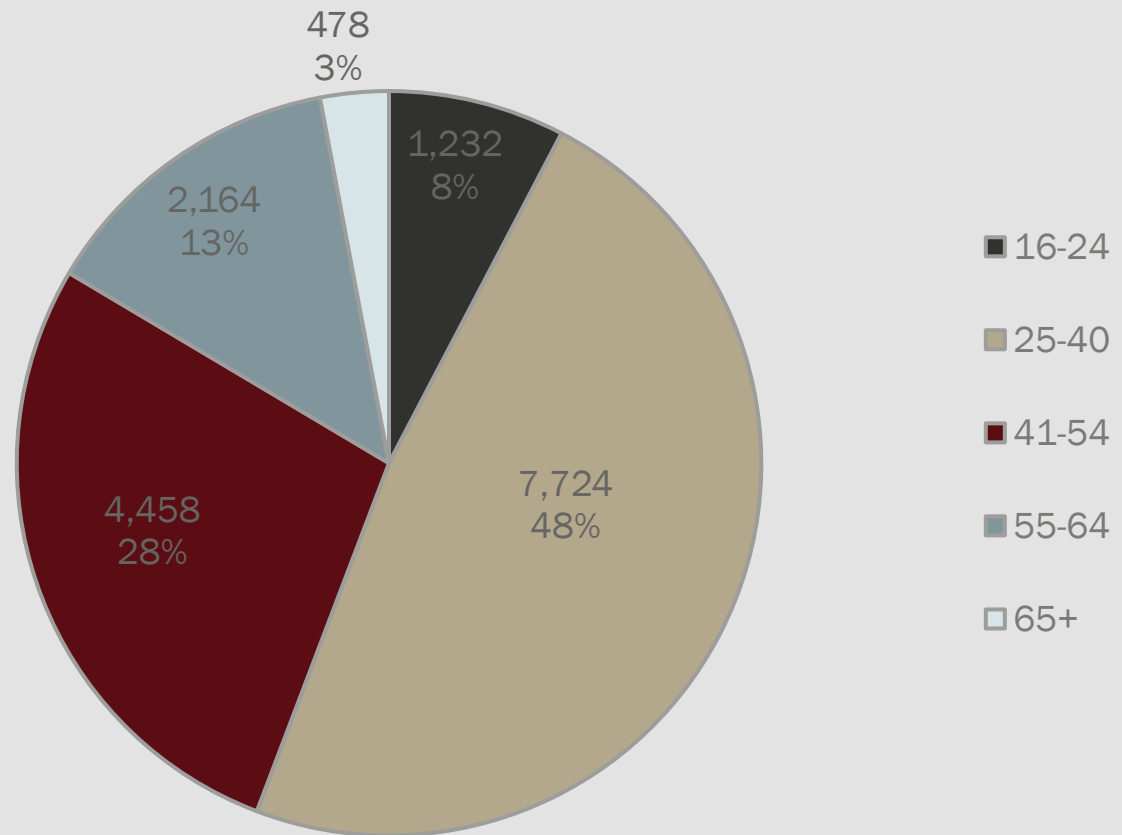

UI Claimants by Age

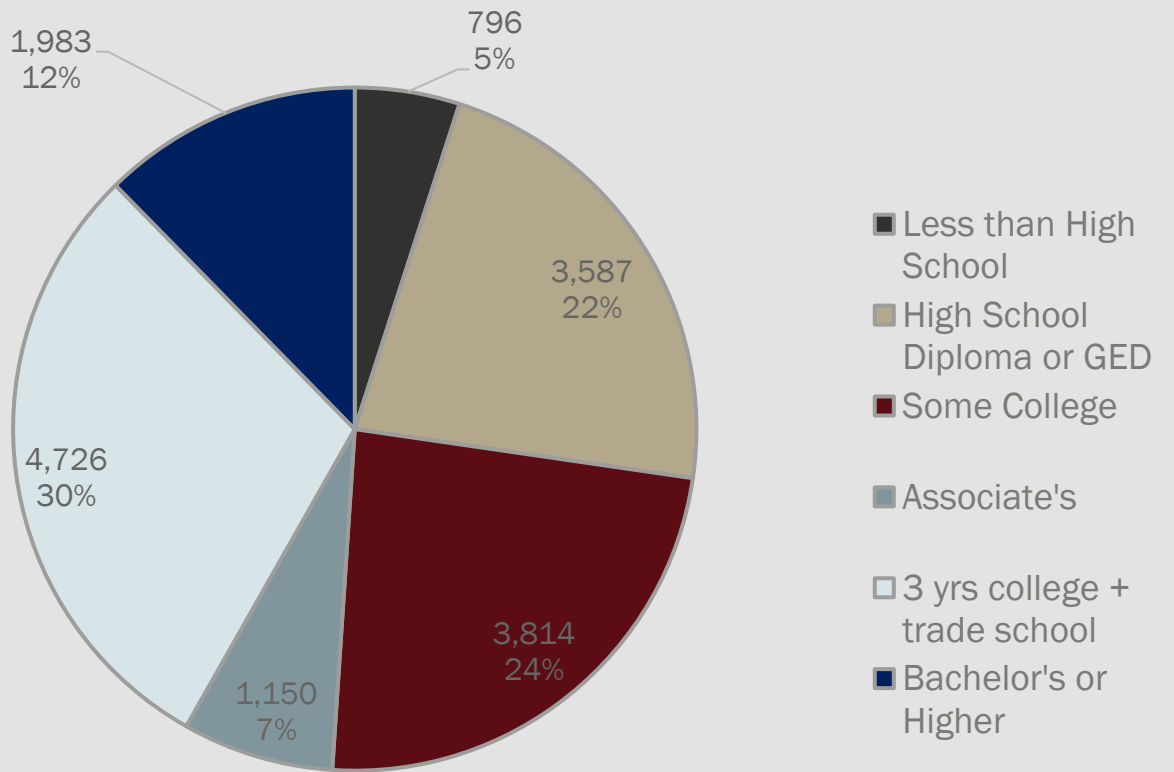
