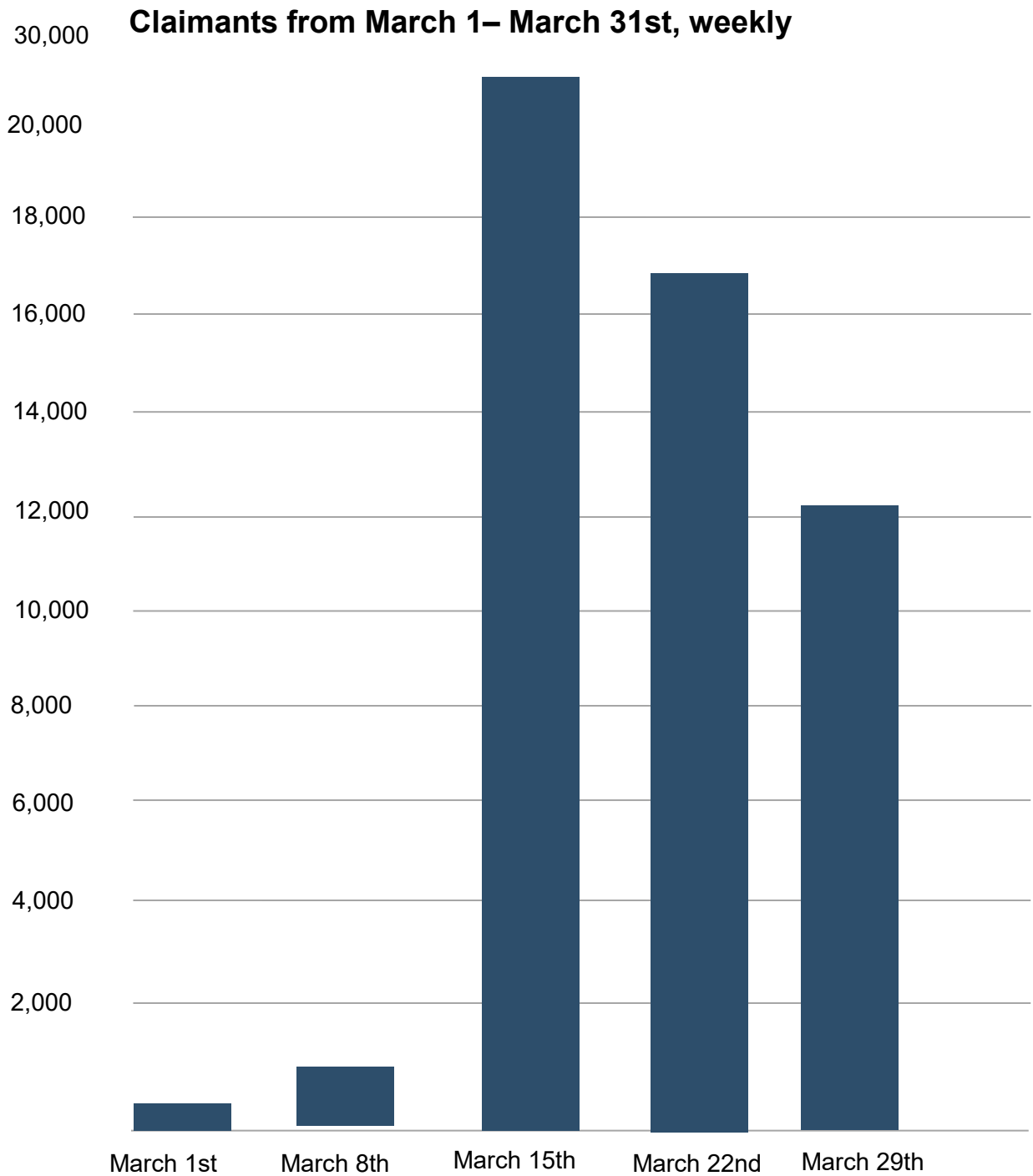

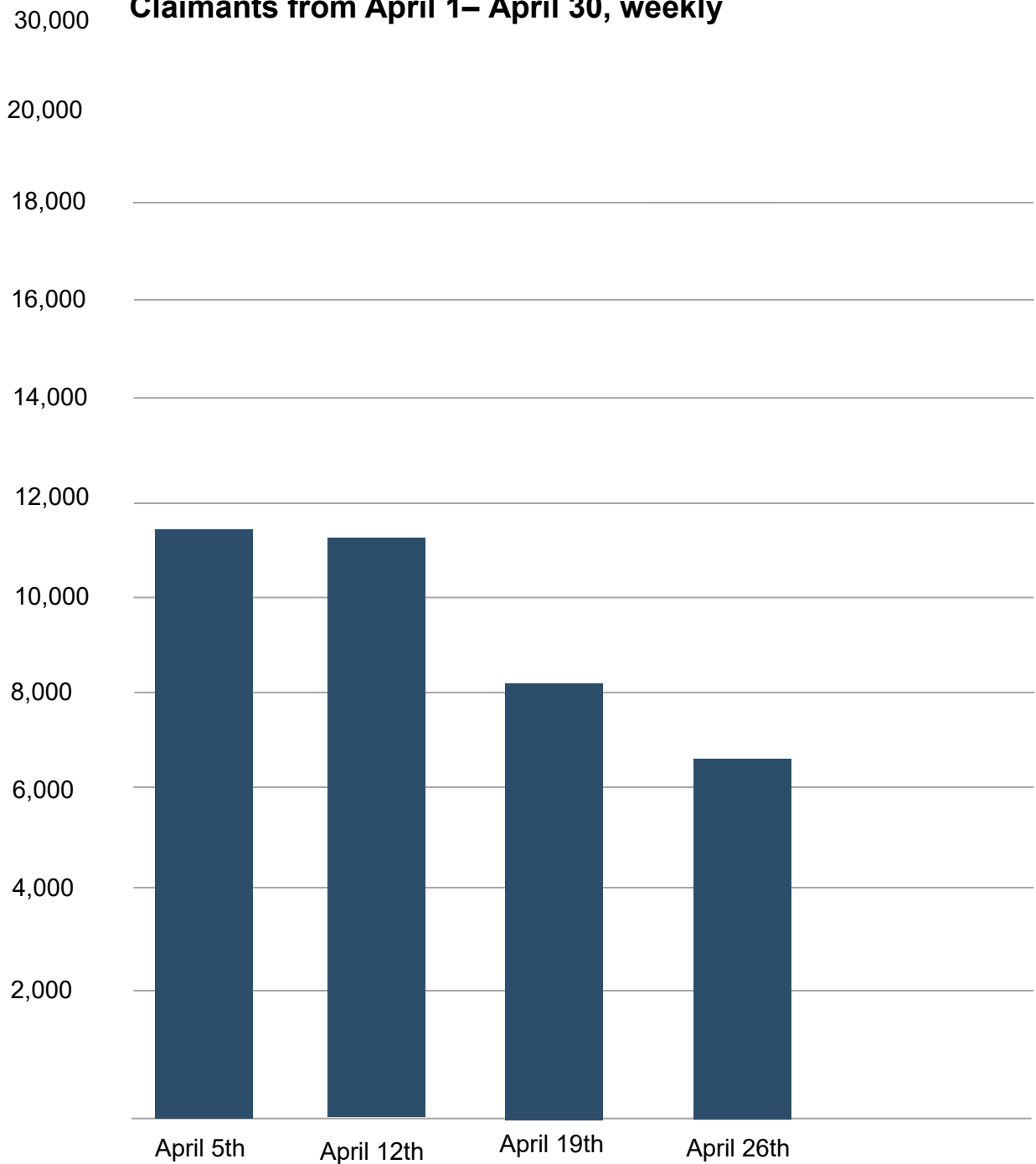

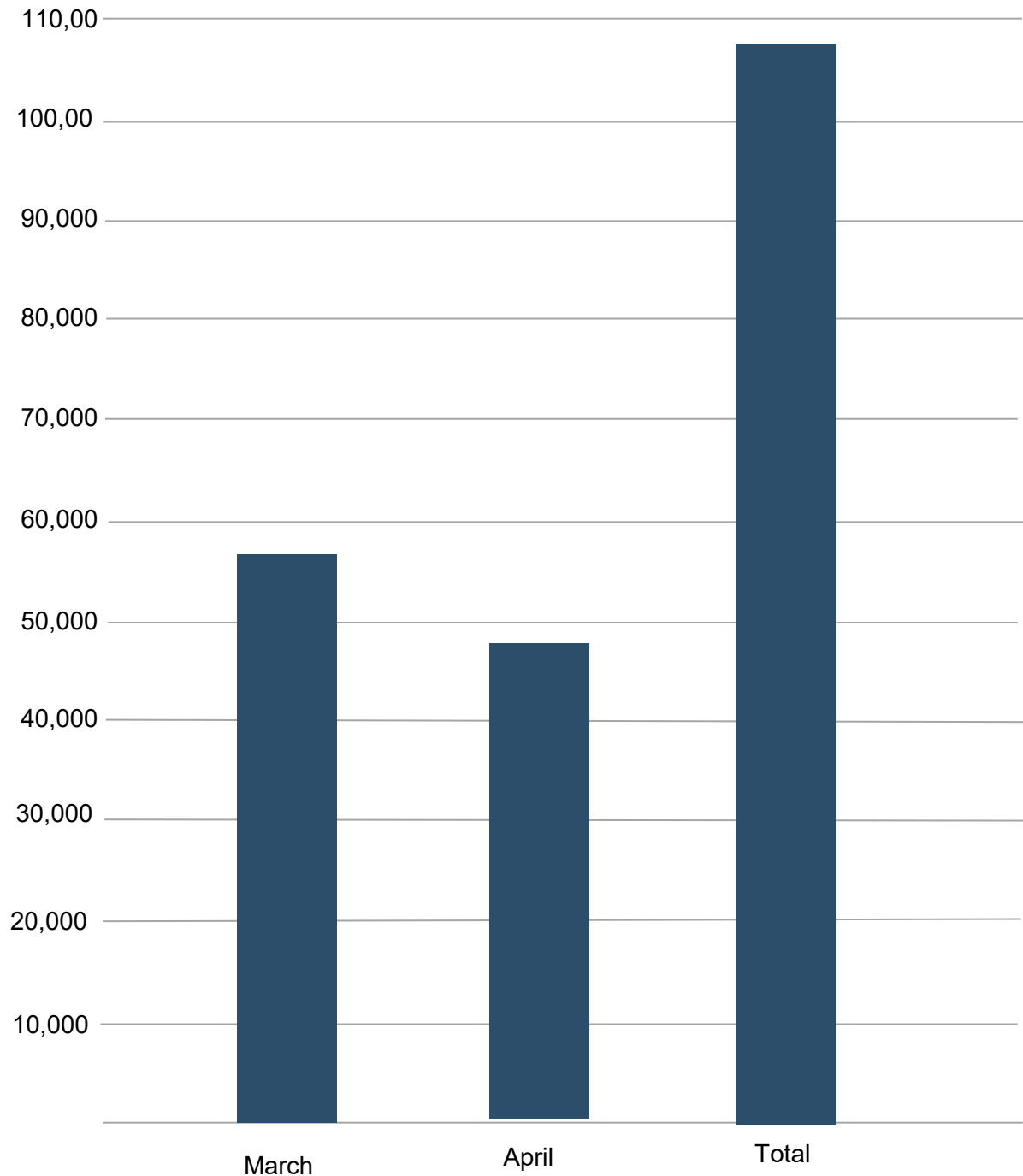

Claimant comparison, monthly



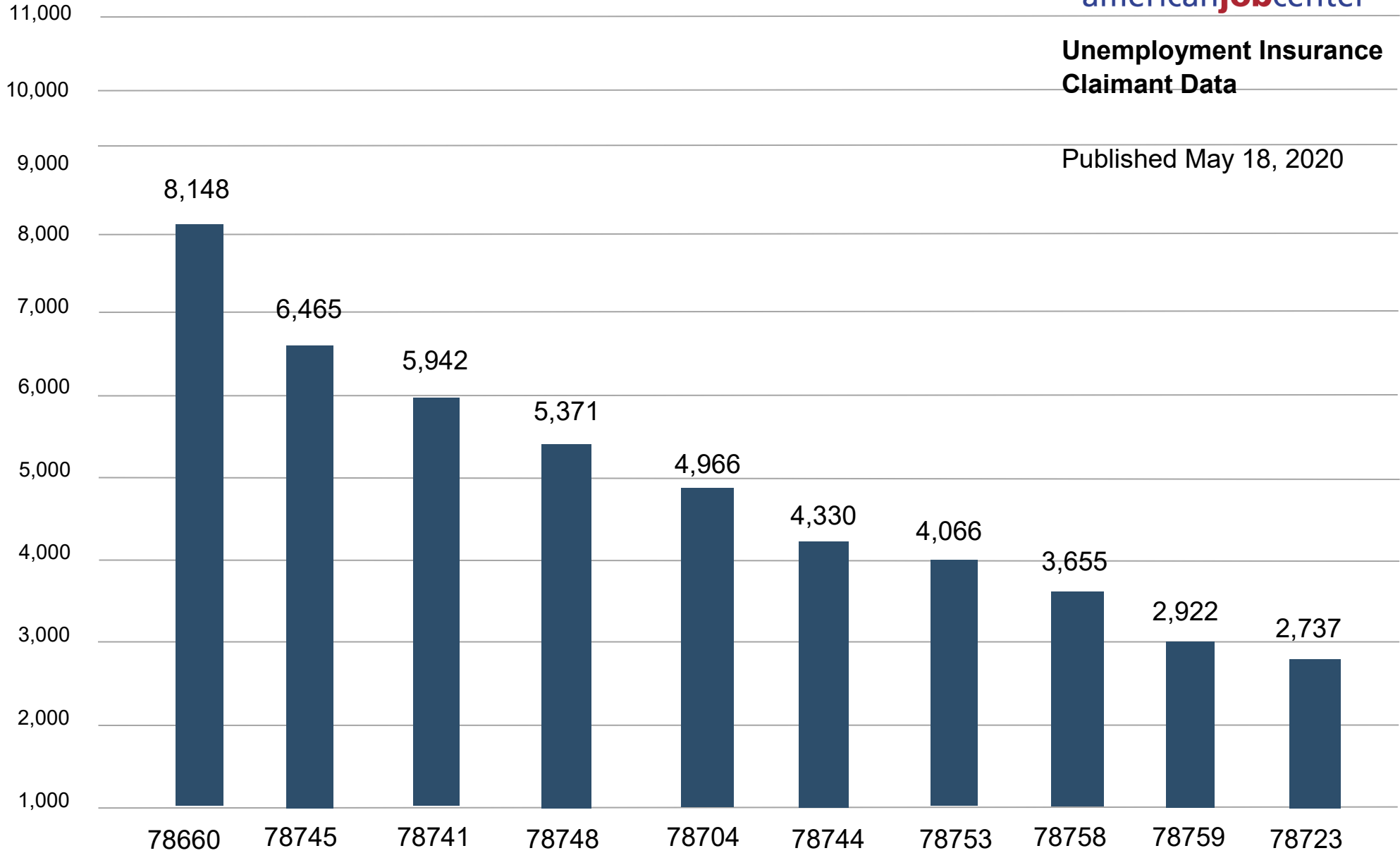
Top 10 claimant ZIP codes

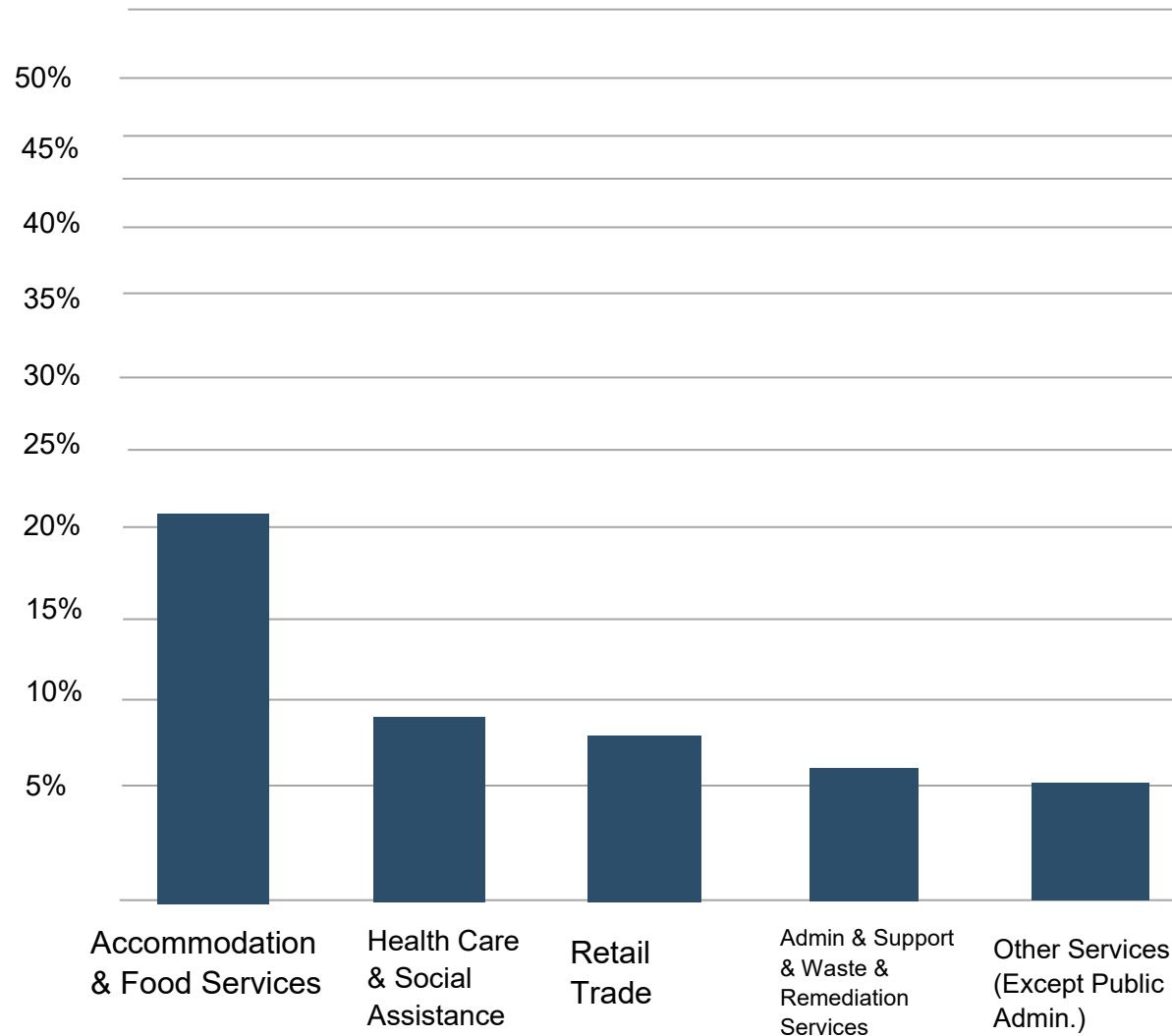

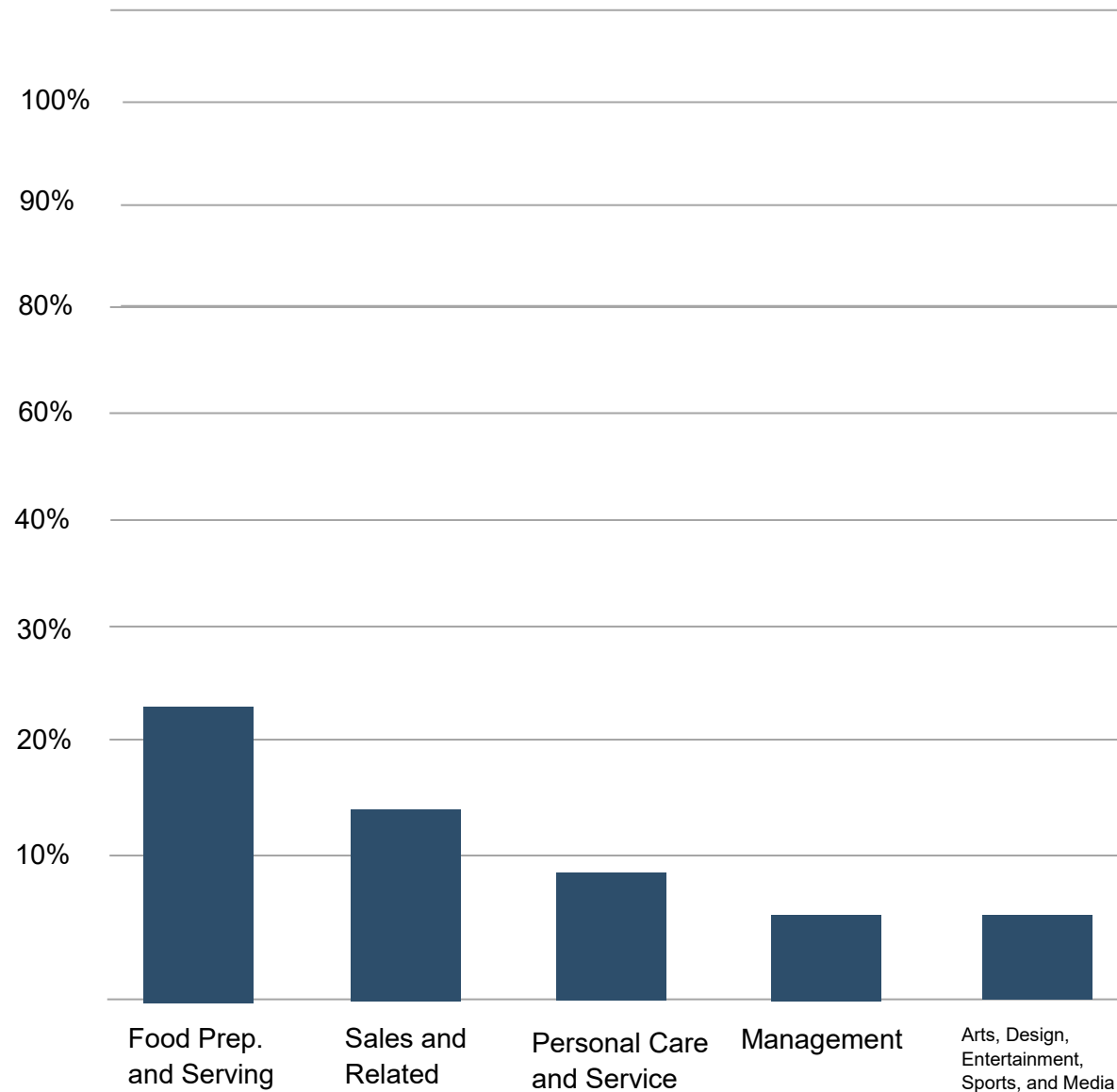

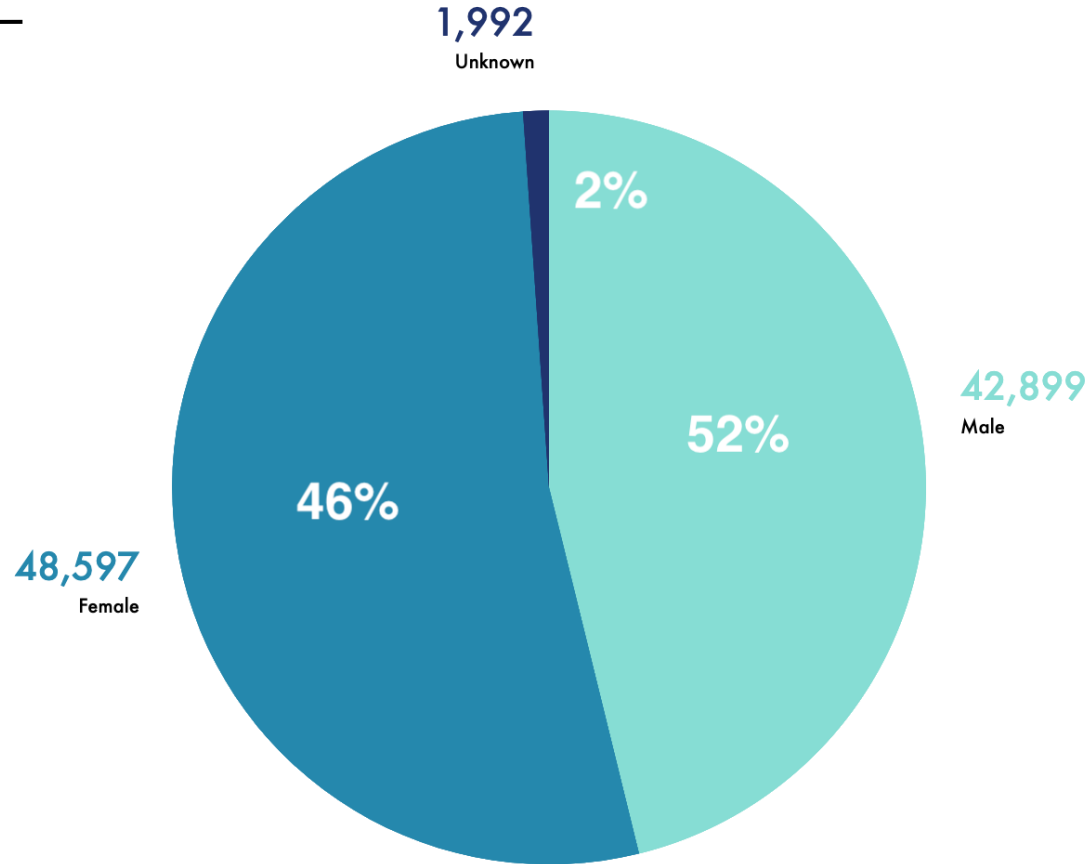

Gender



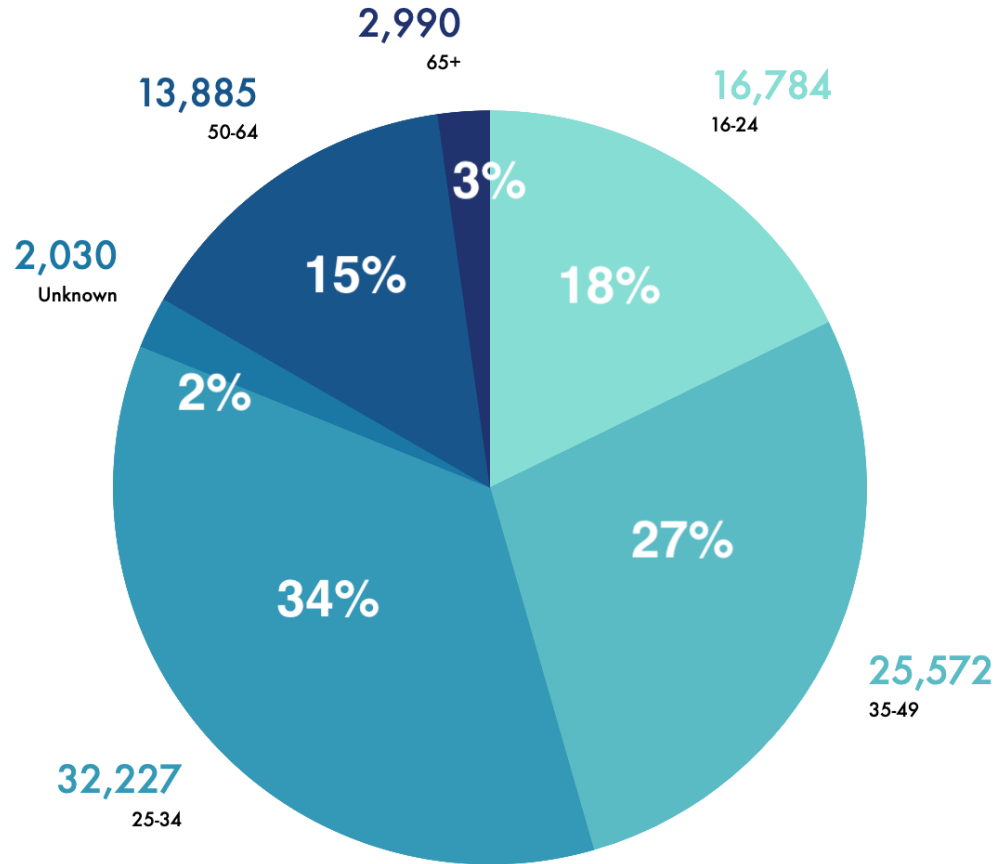

Age

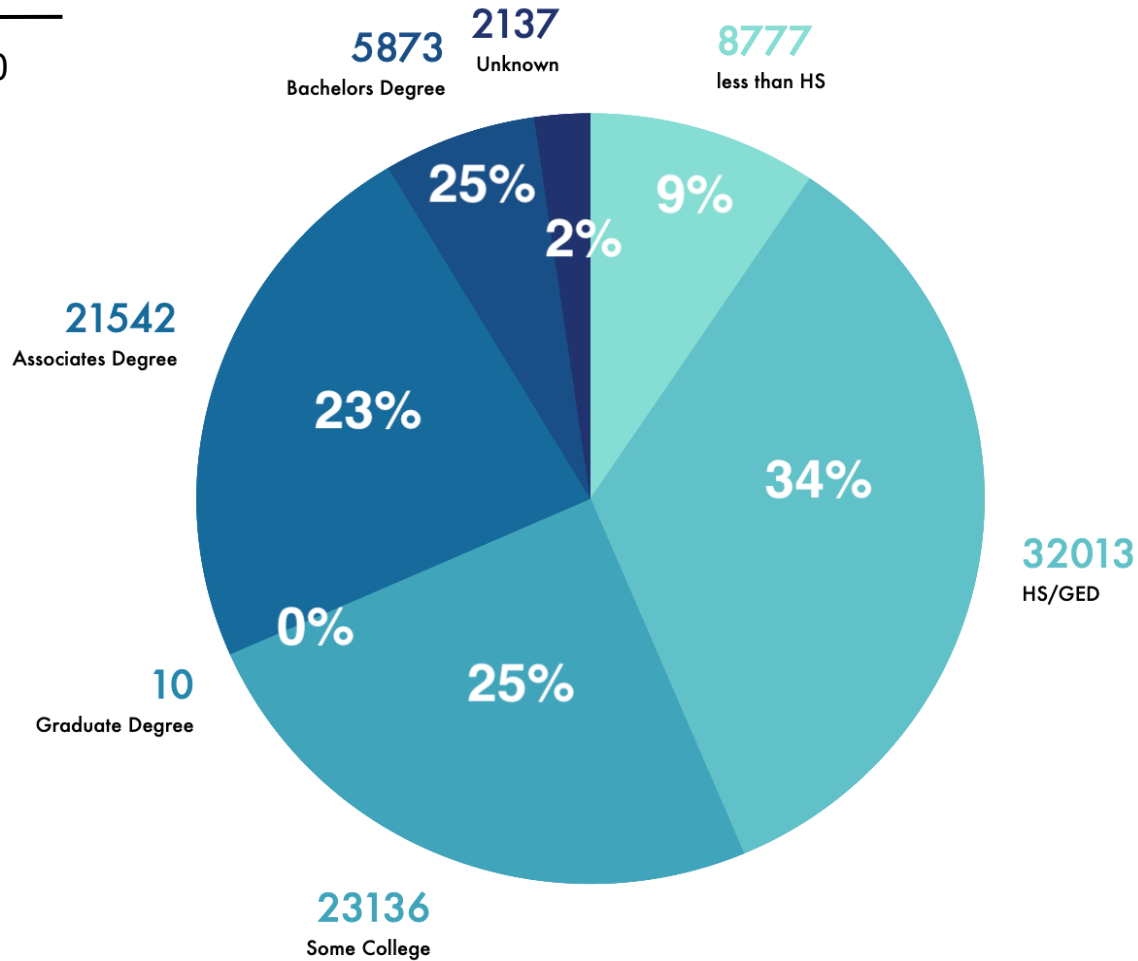

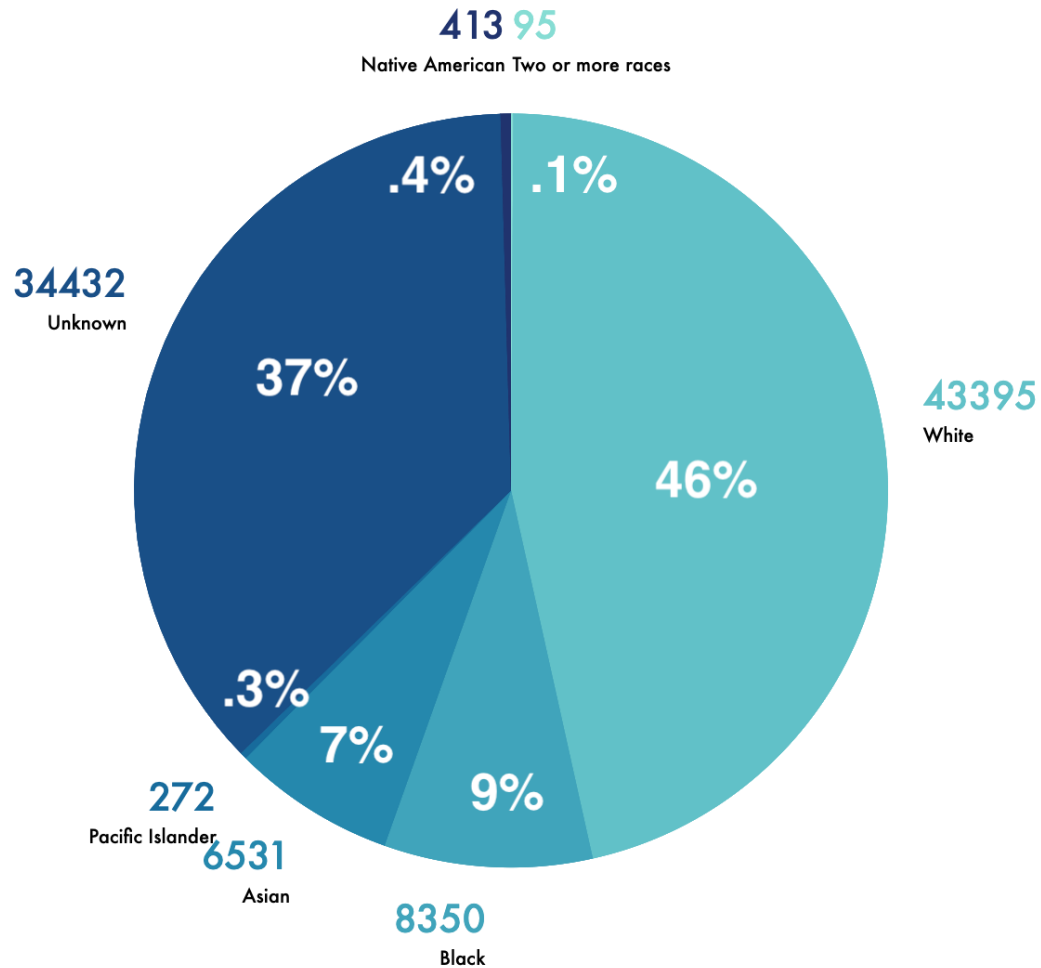

Race



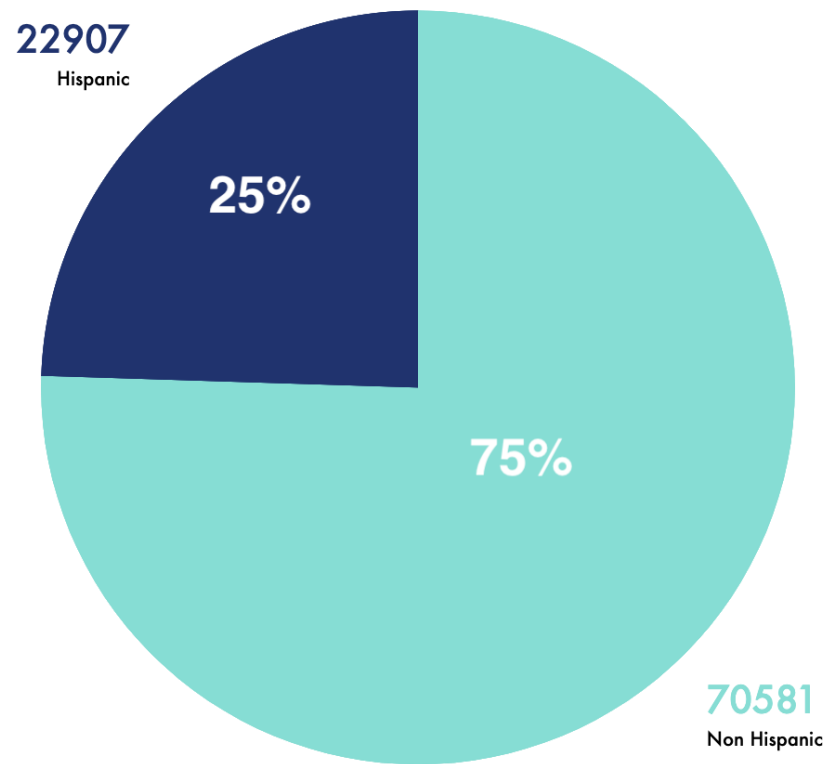

Race



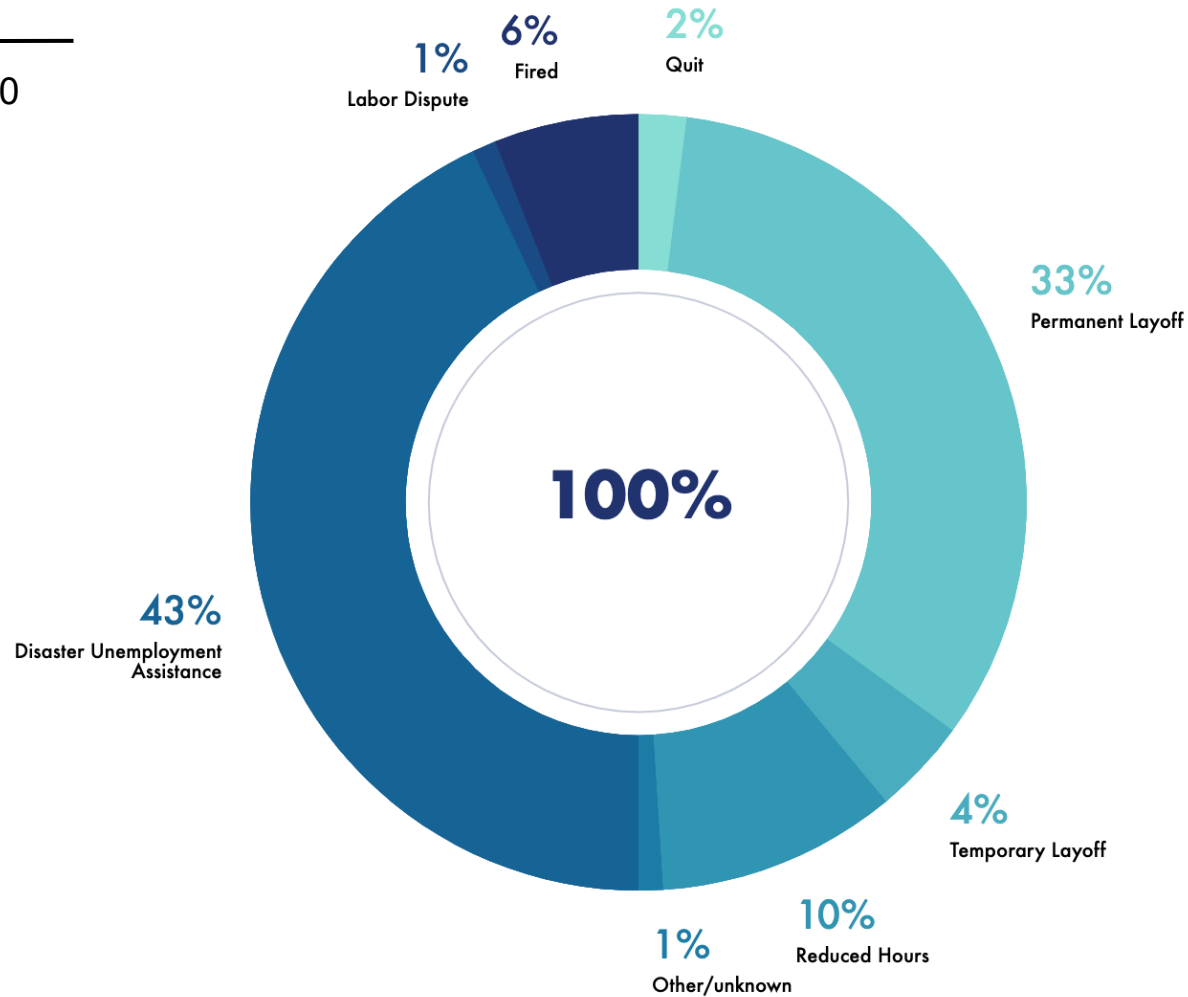
