



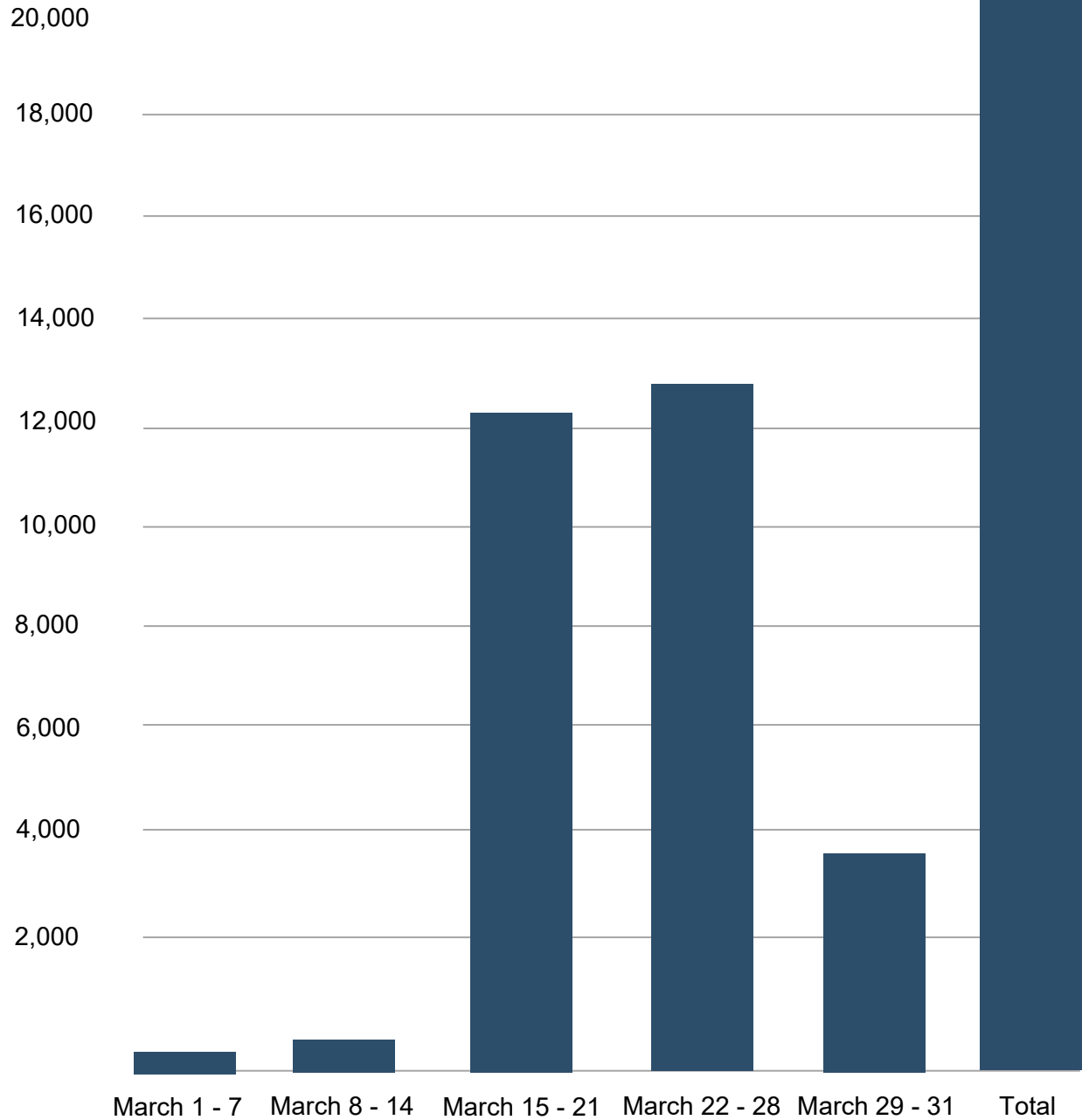

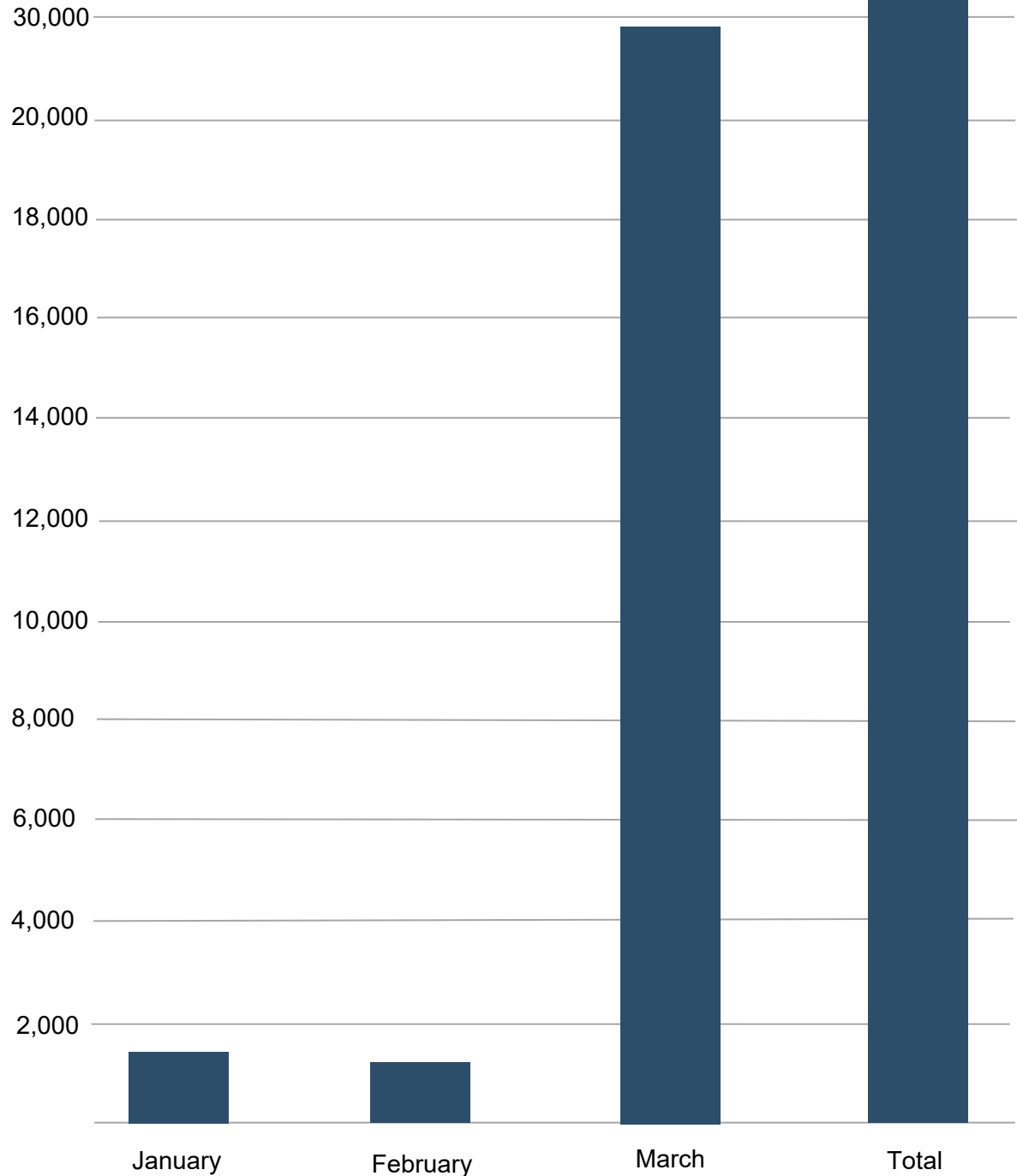

## Claimant comparison, monthly

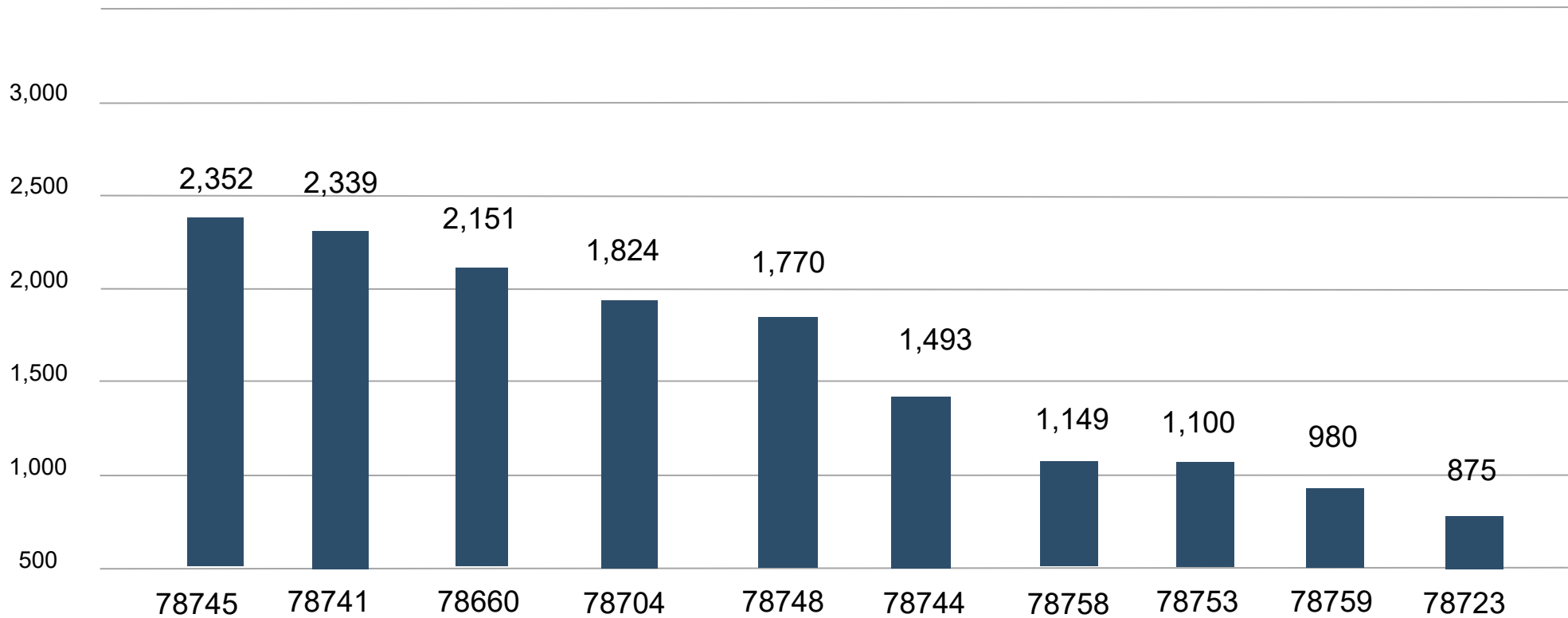

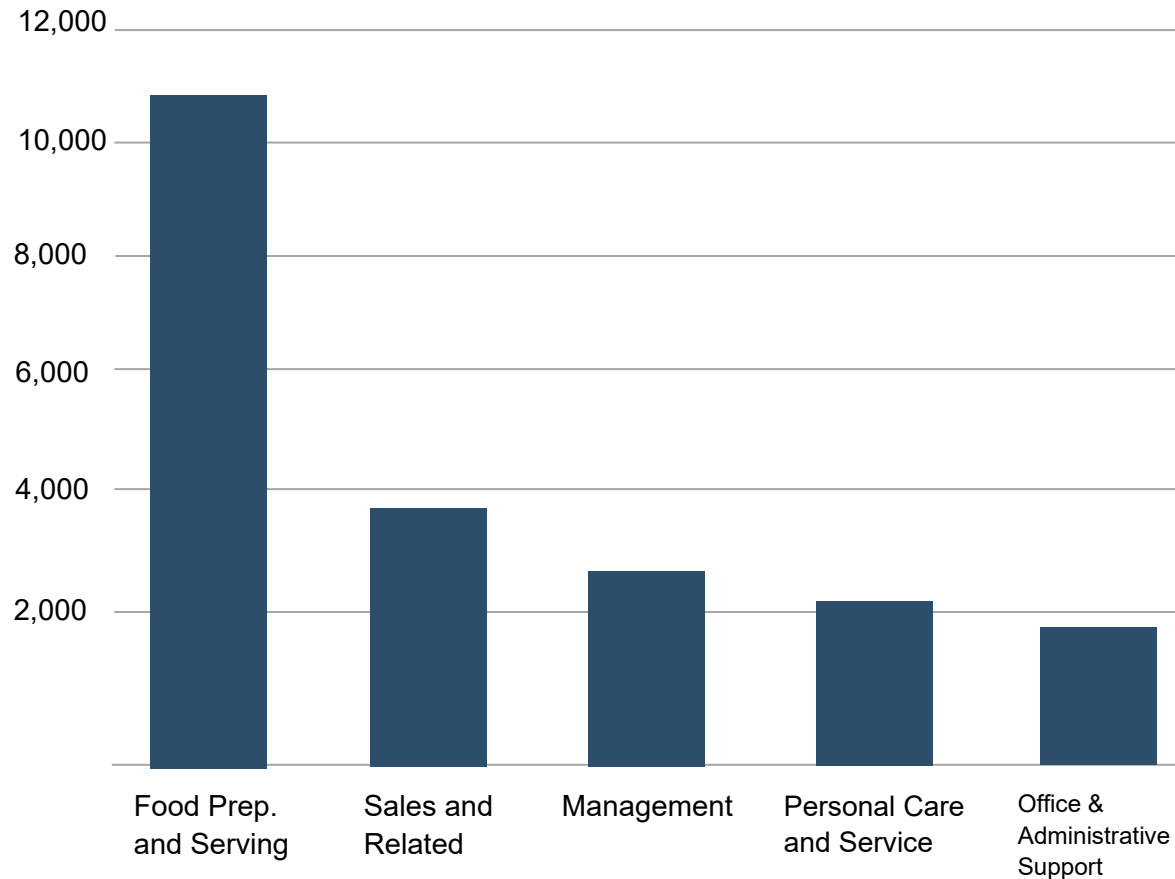

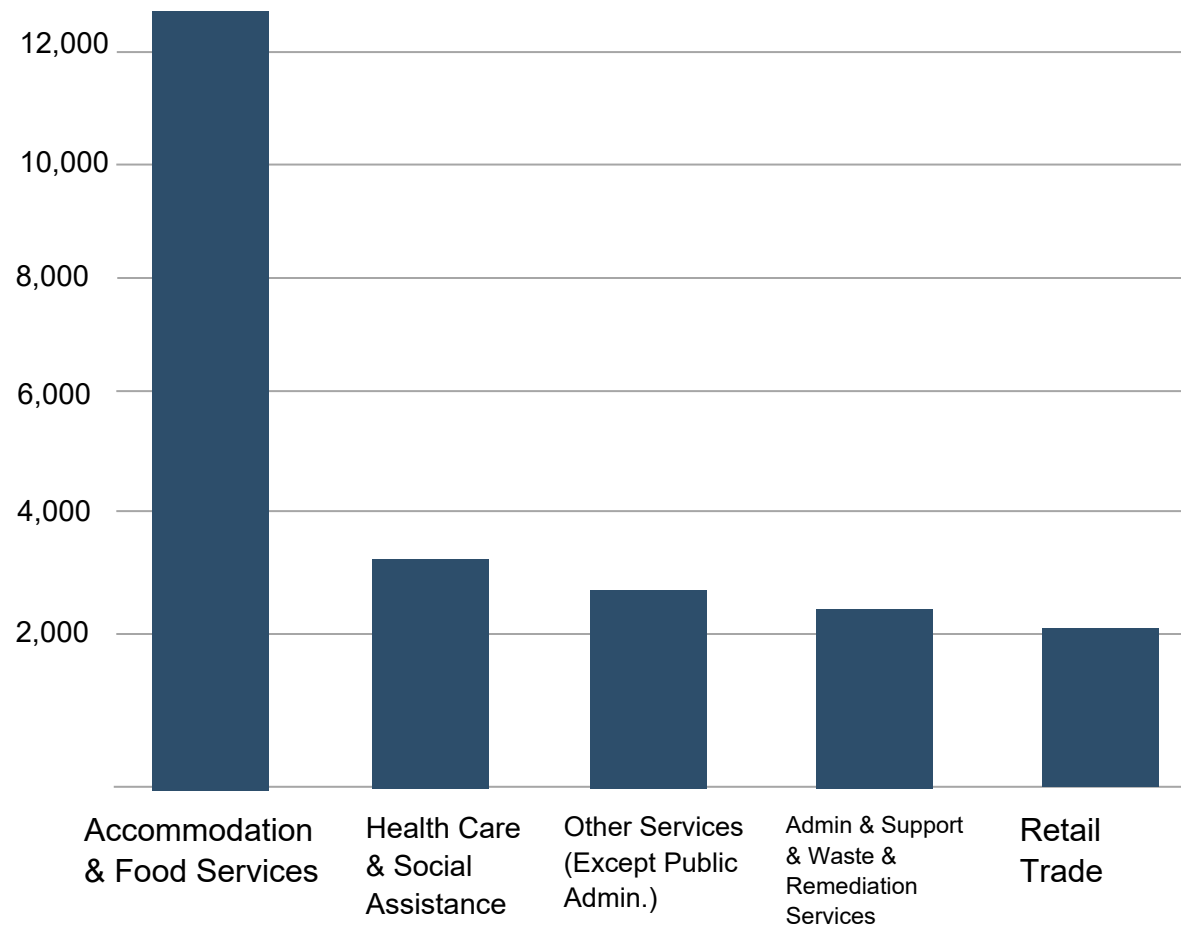

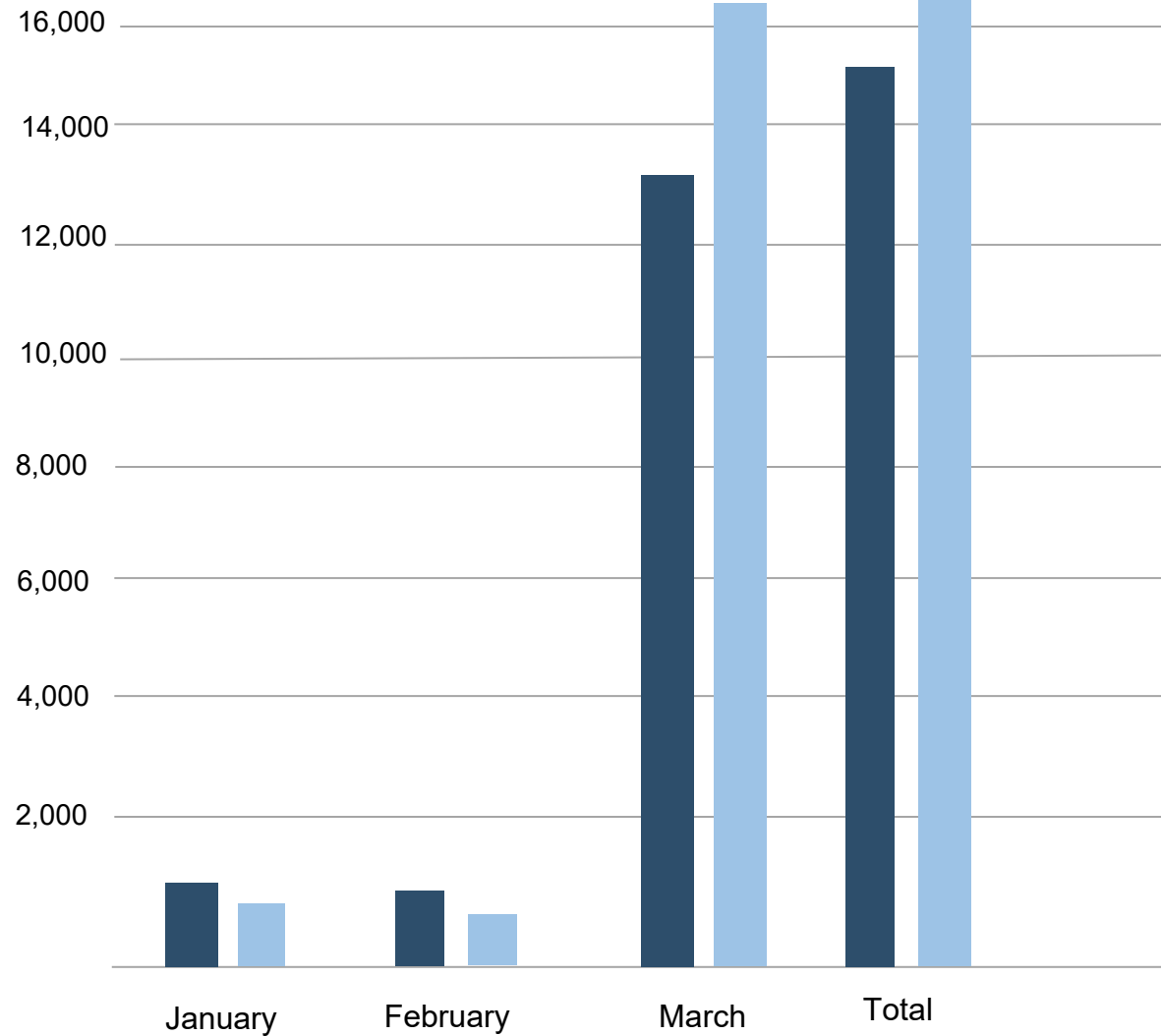

## Claimants by gender in Travis County





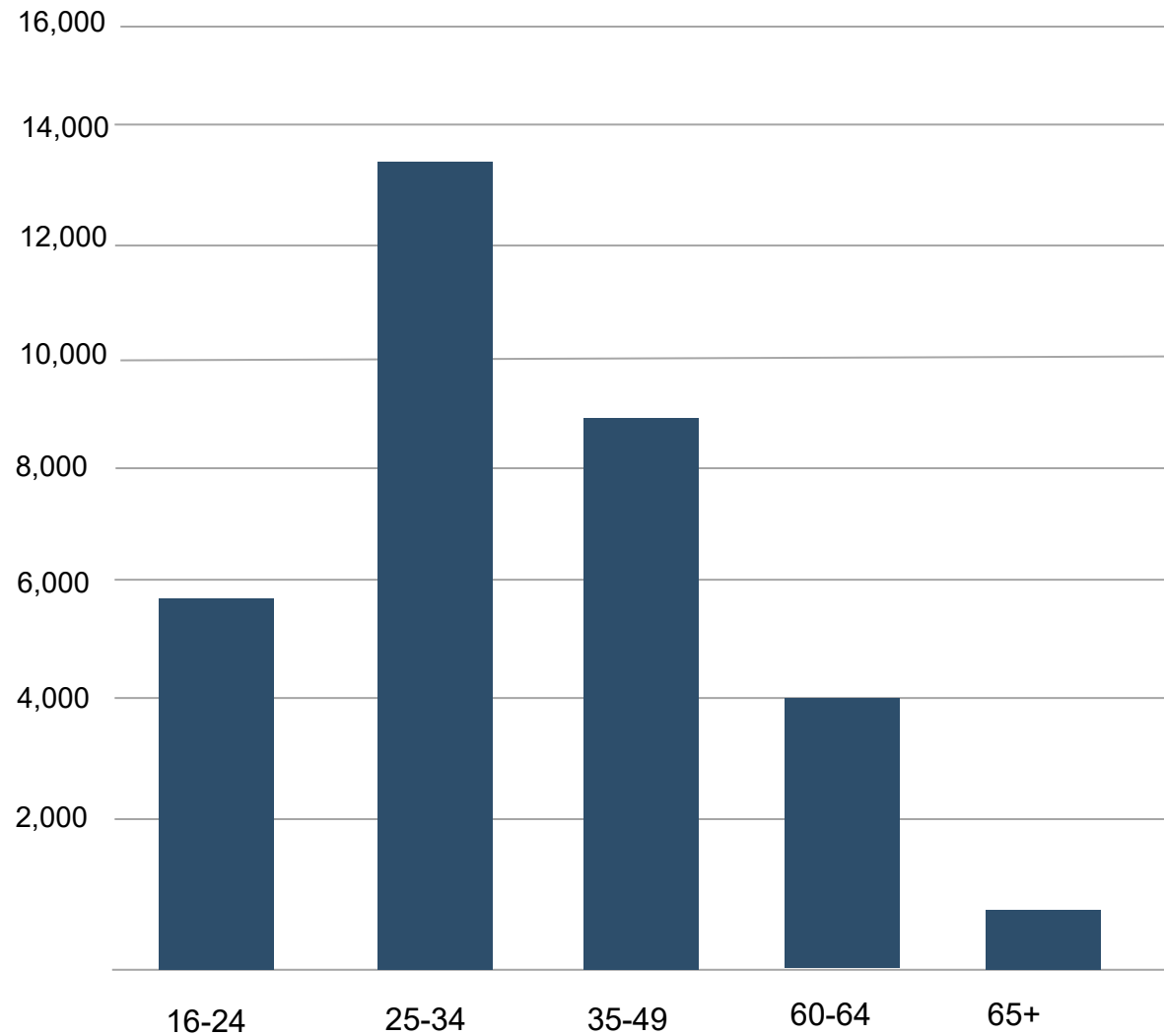
