Activity #1: Conduct an **informational interview** with your family!

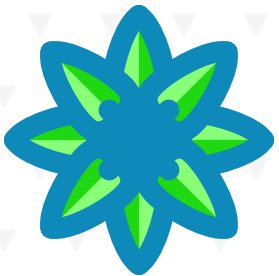
Ask them these questions:

Brainstorm your ideas here - write it out or even draw!

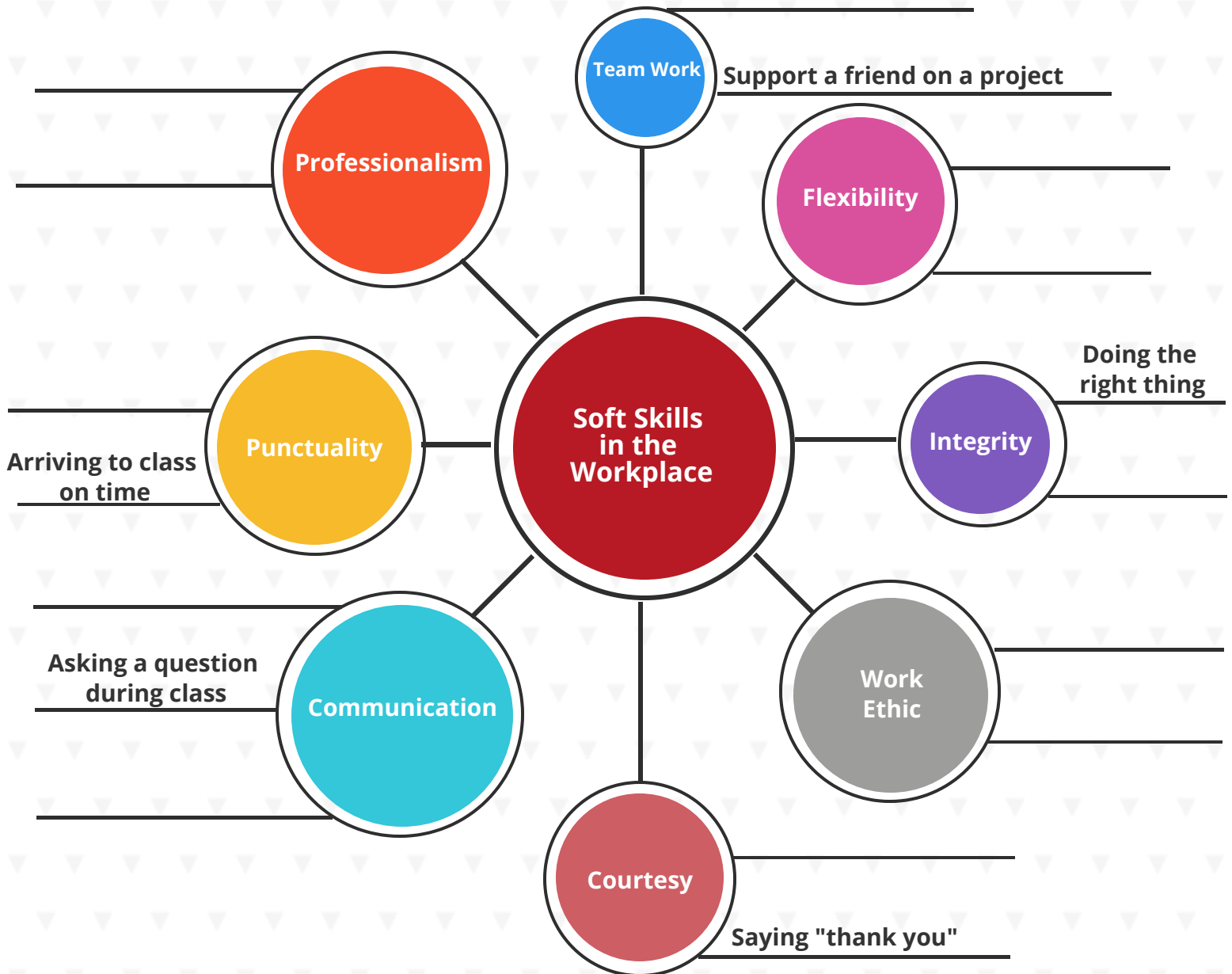


What skills do I need?
