KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS NEEDED

WHAT TYPE OF EDUCATION AND/OR TRAINING WILL I NEED? Insurance sales agents are typically required to have a high school diploma to enter the occupation. However, employers may prefer to hire candidates who have a bachelor's degree. Agents must be licensed in the states where they work.

WILL I NEED A SPECIAL LICENSE OR CERTIFICATION?

Insurance sales agents must have a license in the states where they work. Separate licenses are required for agents to sell life and health insurance and property and casualty insurance. In most states, licenses are issued only to applicants who complete specified courses and who pass state exams covering insurance fundamentals and state insurance laws.
