Workforce Solutions Capital Area administers Child Care Services (CCS) funding to help Austin-Travis County parents pay for child care while they work, go to school, or participate in job training.

You may be eligible if you meet our income guidelines and:

- You are a single parent working or in training/school at least 25 hours/week.
- You are a two-parent household with both parents working or in training/school a combination of at least 50 hours/week.
- You are looking for work.

**Note:** Enrollment in the child care program is subject to the availability of funds. We work to actively enroll children into care, but when enrollment into the program is not immediately available, we ask eligible parents to complete a pre-assessment form to be added to the waitlist.
